



## Leicestershire lose in British Isles triples final

After a quiet start with both teams scoring two shots each on the first three ends. On end four Scotland were holding shot but the Scotland skip moved the jack for two shots to Blaby, then A Irons drew another three shots without reply for England to go five shots up. Again Scotland hit back with a run of 2,3,2,1 to go 15-10 up. England came back with 1,2,2,1 to square the game at 16-6 after sixteen ends. End seventeen was crucial with England holding two shots with only one Scotland bowl to come, the skip fired at the head, was off target, hit a short and wide bowl, flew back into the head, picked up the jack for one shot to Scotland.
