



# Midland Counties League 2010

## 8<sup>th</sup> August 2010

Leicestershire played Nottinghamshire at Enderby on Saturday in the final round of the Midland County League.

Leicestershire fielded a team that welcomed back Andy Irons, Steve Wade, Dean Harrison and John Torrington of Blaby who were unavailable last week because of the Regional Finals of the National Club Two Fours. Leicestershire needed eighteen points to guarantee winning the league and started off very well and after five ends had moved thirty four shots in front with Patrick Hulbert's rink leading the way with a 18-1 lead against the Nottinghamshire rink skipped by Bowls England President Chris Smith. At ten ends Leicestershire were thirty five shots up and winning on four rinks. Leicestershire moved to fifty nine shots at fifteen ends and the game was over as far as the County winning was concerned but still needed to win on the four rinks. The final score was 161-106 in Leicestershire's favour with Patrick Hulbert's rink winning by twenty three shots, Shane Hayes's rink winning by twenty one shots, Andy Irons rink winning by twenty shots and S Wade's rink winning by four shots.

This result means that Leicestershire have now won the Midland County League three years in a row and this is a new record for Leicestershire Bowls.

## 1<sup>st</sup> August 2010

Leicestershire played Lincolnshire at Leicester B.C. on Saturday in the penultimate round of the Midland County League.

Leicestershire had to field a team without four Middleton Cup skips and in total had thirteen players unavailable for various reasons. Leicestershire started off very well and after five ends had moved eleven shots ahead but Lincolnshire hit back and after ten ends had closed the gap to four shots. At eighteen ends Leicestershire were eight shots up and increased this to ten shots after nineteen ends but on the twentieth end Leicestershire lost seven shots to lead by three shots going into the last end. The two losing rinks picked up three shots between them and John Bowman's rink picked up another two shots but Shane Hayes rink lost a three and Patrick Hulbert's rink lost two shots to leave Leicestershire three shots up with only Peter Hobbs's rink to finish. They lost one shot to give Leicestershire a two shot win, winning 112-110 with three winning rinks and a drawn game giving a total of seventeen points.

This win leaves Leicestershire in second place, nine points behind Warwickshire and five points ahead of third placed Northamptonshire. Warwickshire have completed all their games so a win for Leicestershire or Northamptonshire would see them overtake Warwickshire. Leicestershire need eighteen points to guarantee them winning the league.

#### **26<sup>th</sup> July 2010**

Leicestershire play Lincolnshire at Leicester B.C. on Saturday needing a win to keep them in the running for the Midland County League. Leicestershire have at least Three Middleton Cup skips missing due to other Bowling commitments and this will really test the strength of the squad.

#### **26<sup>th</sup> June 2010**

Leicestershire men played their fourth Midland County game of the season at home to second placed Northamptonshire at Enderby B.C. on Saturday. With eight players unavailable it was a much changed team from previous weeks.

Northamptonshire started off well and were five shots up at five ends. At ten ends it was still Northamptonshire in front by one shot and at fifteen ends it was still Northamptonshire in front by two shots. Eighteen ends and it was still Northamptonshire by three shots. Something had to change and Leicestershire have been finishing well all season and this was no exception. Over the last three ends Peter Hobbs and Patrick Hulbert's rink both picked up seven shots and although the other four rinks lost by nine shots the five shot swing gave Leicestershire a two shot win and sixteen points to six.

This win puts Leicestershire twenty two points clear at the top of the league although all of the other teams have a game in hand. Leicestershire's highest winning rink was shared By Peter Hobbs Patrick Hulbert's rinks as they both won by nineteen shots and thirty five points from the last two games should retain the title.

Leicestershire men played their third away game in a row at Entaco against Warwickshire in the Midland County league.

Leicestershire got off to a poor start with Peter Hobbs rink being the only rink in front and Leicestershire were seventeen shots down at five ends. At ten ends Leicestershire were only six shots down and at fifteen ends Leicestershire were still five shots down but starting to look as if they could win the game. At eighteen ends Leicestershire moved in front by two shots and it was now anybody's game. With three rinks to finish and all playing their last end Leicestershire were one shot down but Peter Hobbs picked up two shots and Dave Simpson picked up one shot to put Leicestershire two up with only John Bowman's rink to finish. With one Bowl to play Bowman was three shots down but with an excellent running bowl he removed two of the shots and left Leicestershire with a one shot win. Leicestershire's highest winning rink was John Torrington, John Cooper, Andy Wye and Peter Hobbs with a ten shot win against the rink skipped by J Freeman and Leicestershire only other winning rink was skipped by John Bowman with a four shot win against the rink skipped by C Wells.
